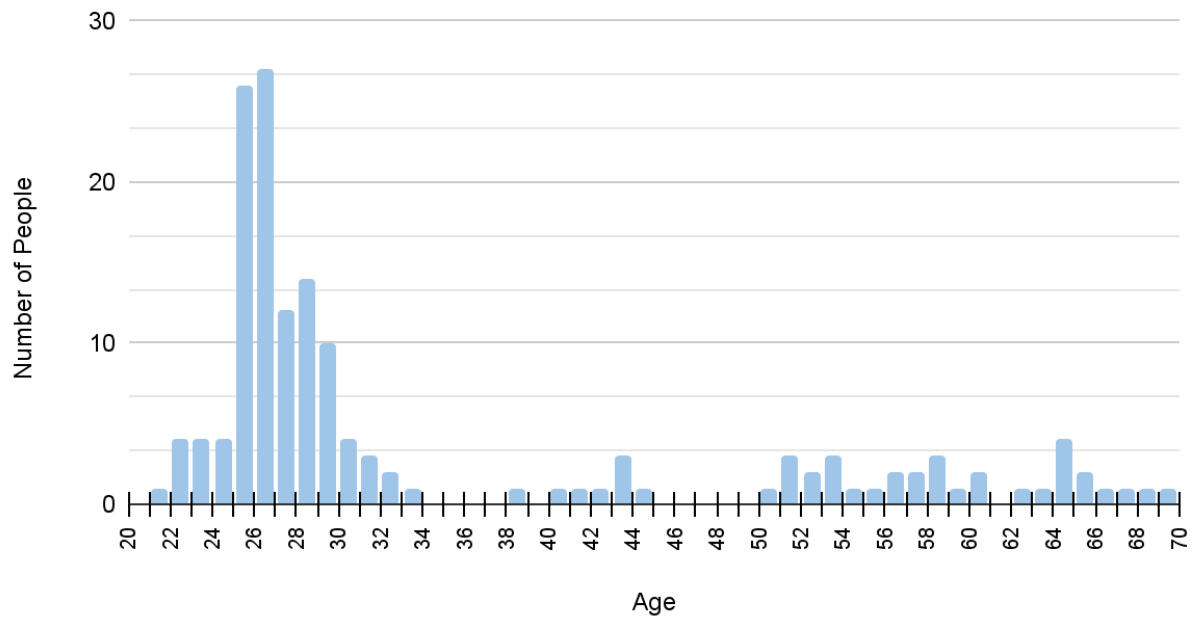


Figure 1: Age

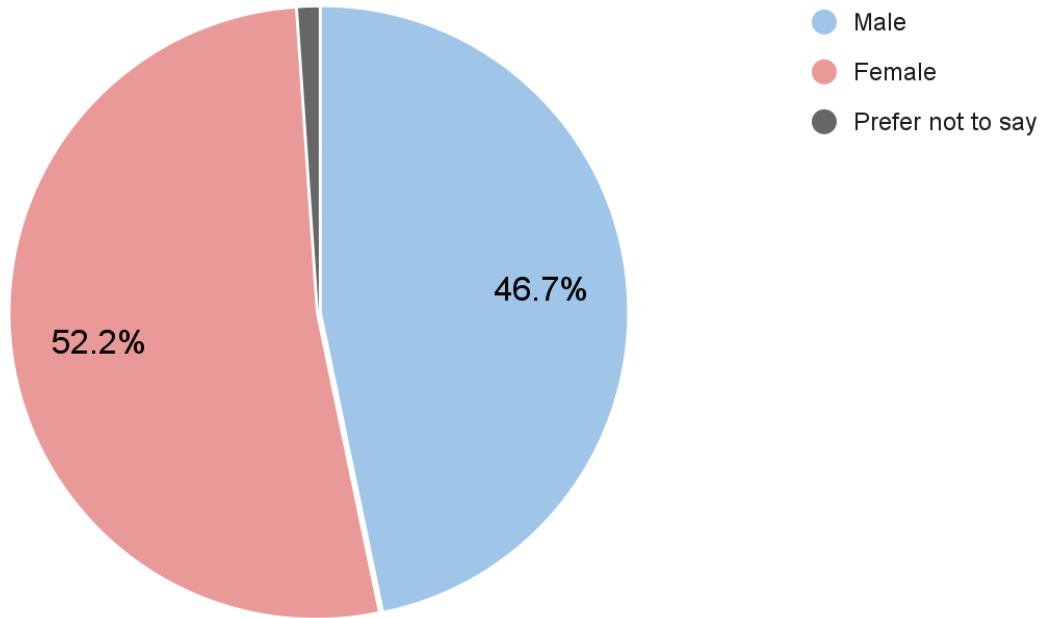


Figure 2: Gender

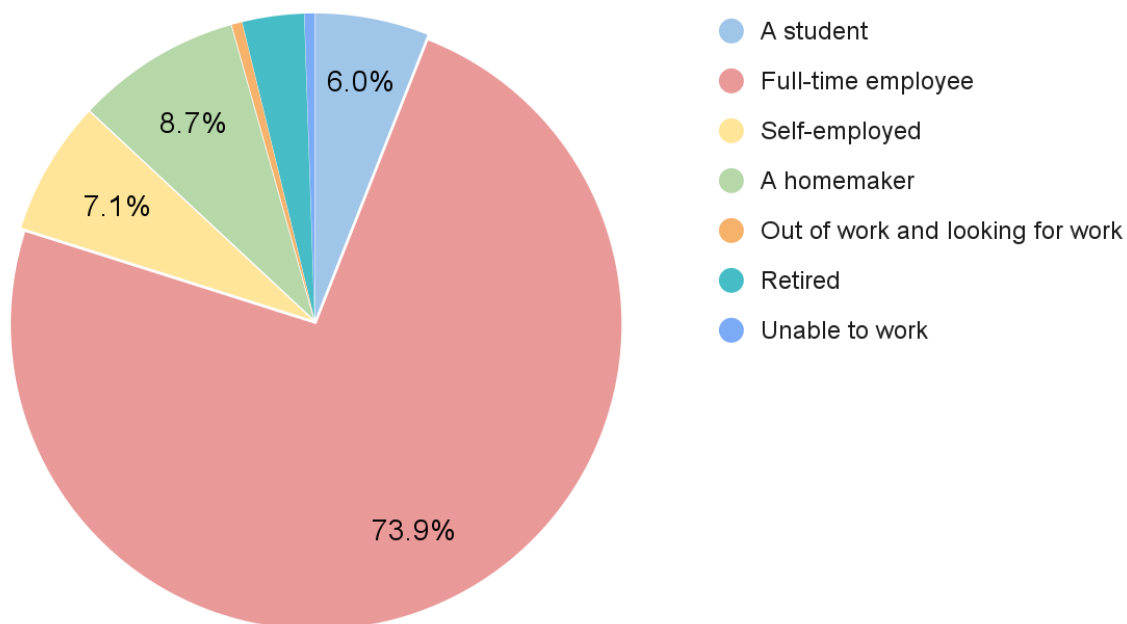


Figure 3: Occupation

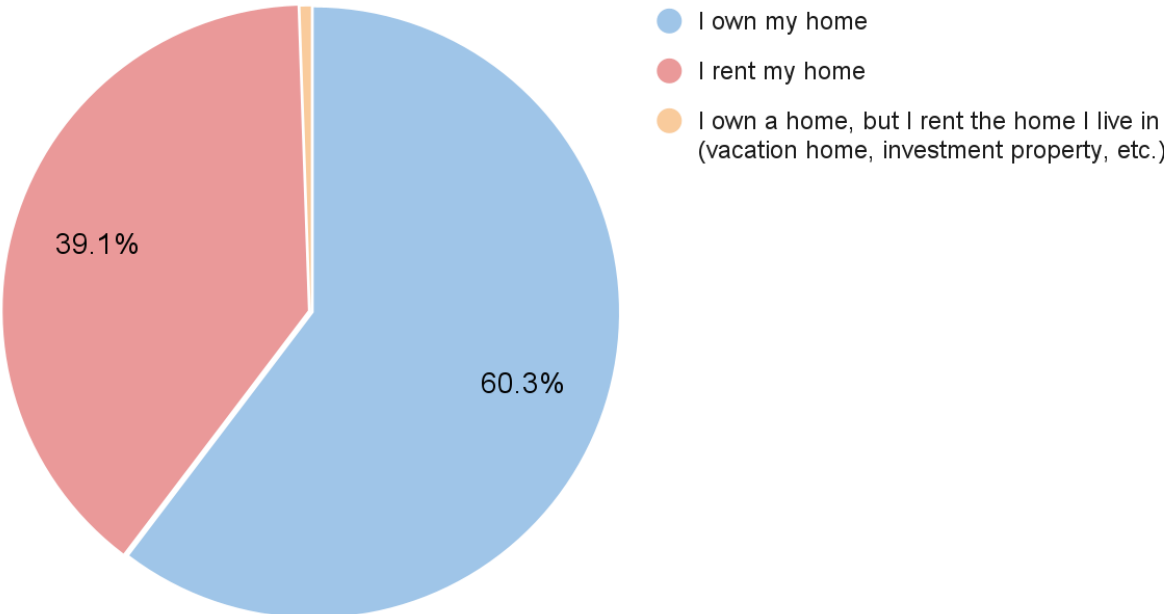


Figure 6: Current Living Situation

What is your current total monthly rent (without utility costs)?

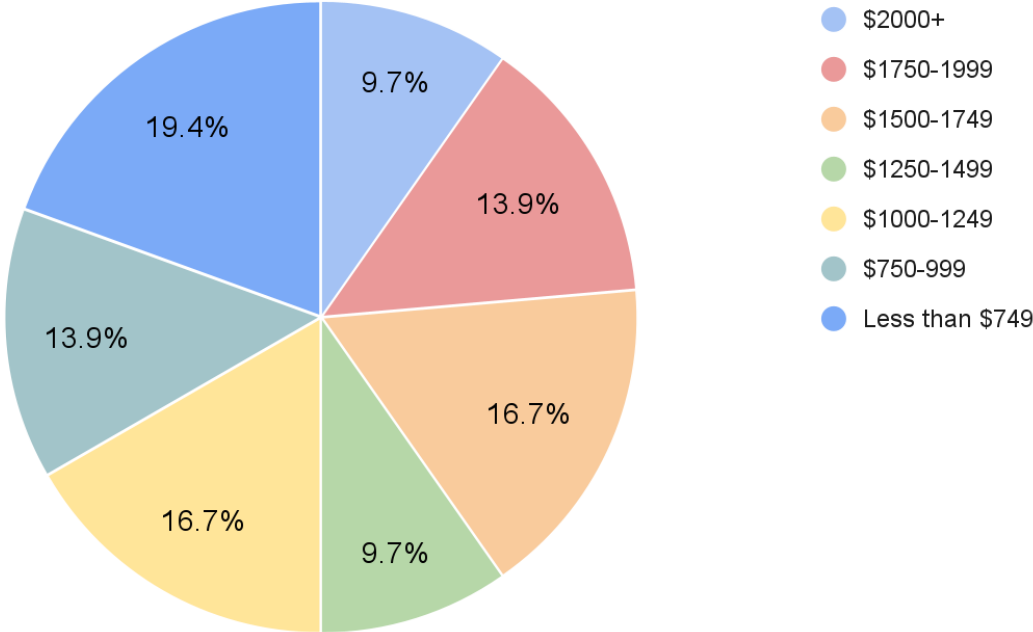


Figure 7: Monthly Rent

On a scale of 1-10, how do you feel about selling a home in the next year?

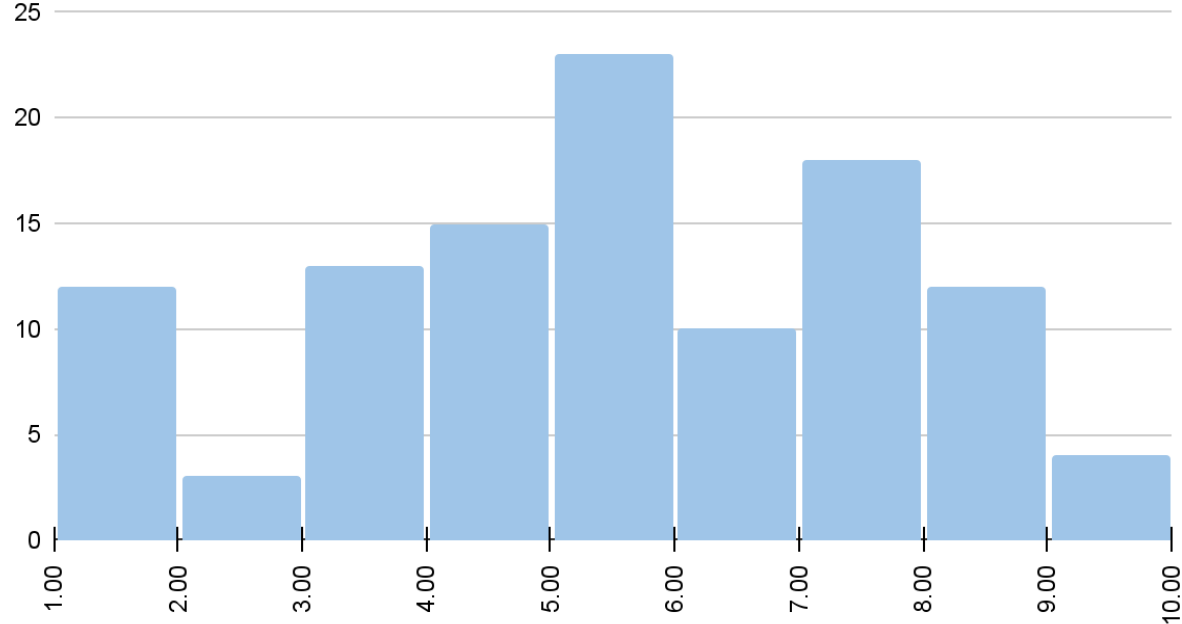


Figure 8: Homeowners outlook on selling

On a scale of 1-10, how do you feel about buying a house in the next year?

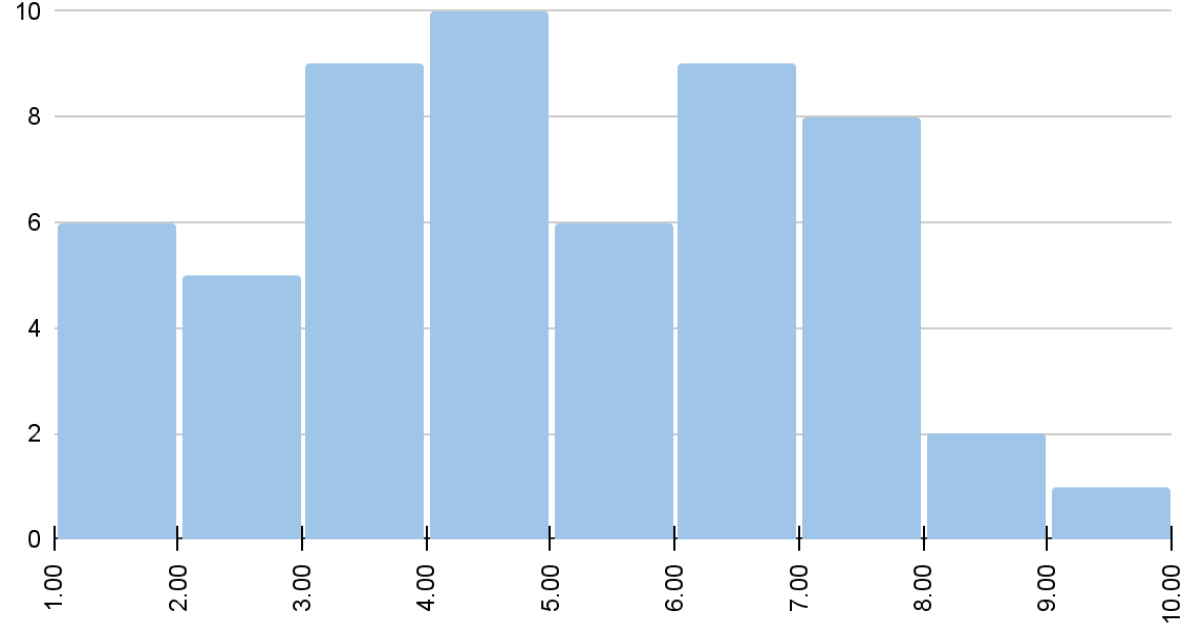


Figure 9: Homeowners outlook on buying

On a scale of 1-10, how do you feel about buying a house in the next year?

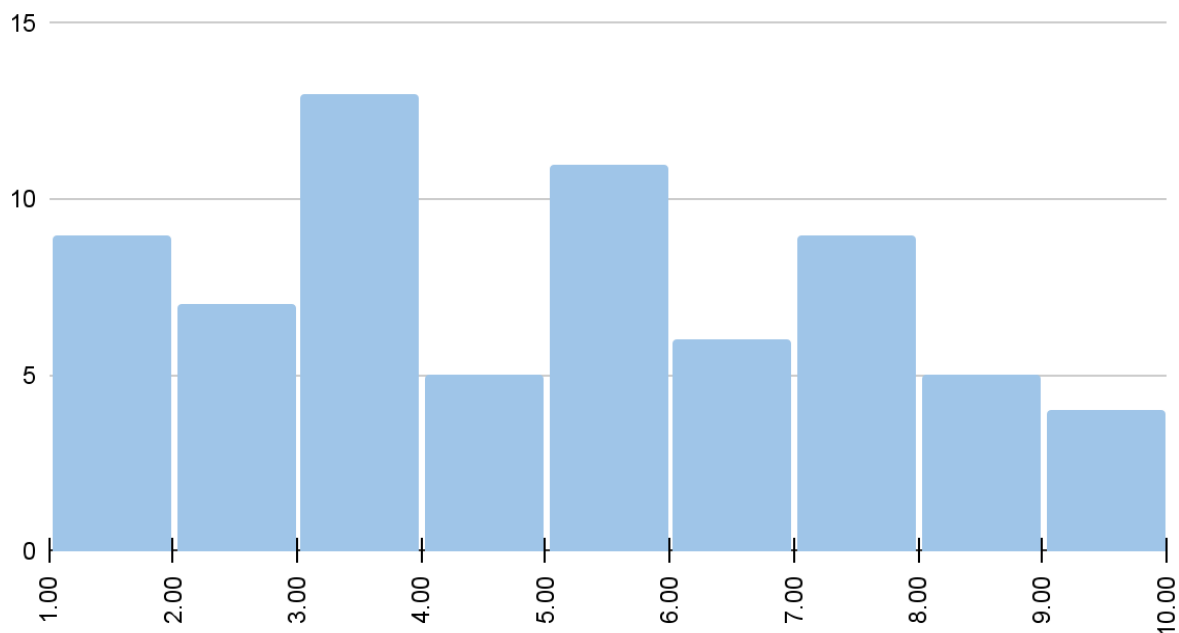


Figure 10: Renters outlook on buying
